A motion to adjourn was made by Vice President Miller at 8:07 p.m. and seconded by Bright—motion passed.

The trust meeting opened at 8:07 p.m.

There was not businesses to discuss and no action taken.

A motion to adjourn the trust meeting was made at 8:08 p.m. by Miller and seconded by Frierdich—motion passed.
